UEFA EURO 2016 Qualifying Competition
European Qualifiers Matchday 5, Israel - Wales of 28 March 2015, corrected kick-off time

Dear Sirs,

We have been informed that on Saturday 28 March 2015 the difference between CET and the local time in Israel will exceptionally be two hours instead of the regular one hour. This is due to the fact that Israel will switch to Summer time on the night from Friday to Saturday whereas in central Europe the clocks will move forward by one hour on the night from Saturday to Sunday.

The guidelines for the European Qualifiers fixture list (see UEFA circular letter 7/2014) stipulate that matches cannot kick-off later than 21:45/22:00 local time. Consequently, the kick-off time for the match Israel versus Wales of Saturday 28 March 2015 has to be corrected to 18:00 CET (20:00 local time) instead of 20:45 CET (22:45 local time). This is the only alternative possible within the framework of centralization, as matches must be played at the standard kick-off times. The switch to the earlier kick-off slot is an exceptional correction to the published European Qualifiers fixture list.

We kindly ask you to forward the above decision to all parties concerned.
